


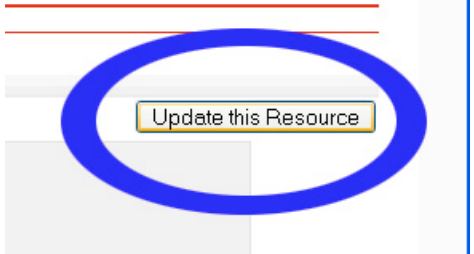
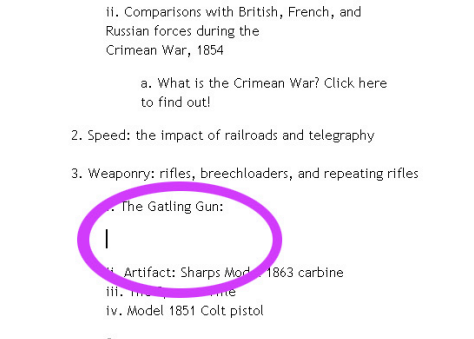

What is this feature?

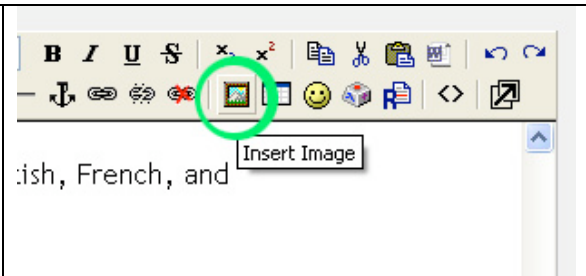
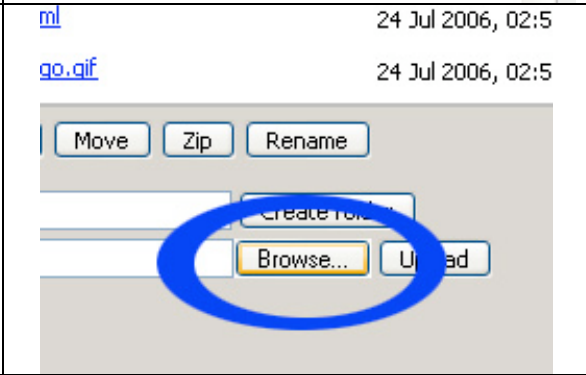
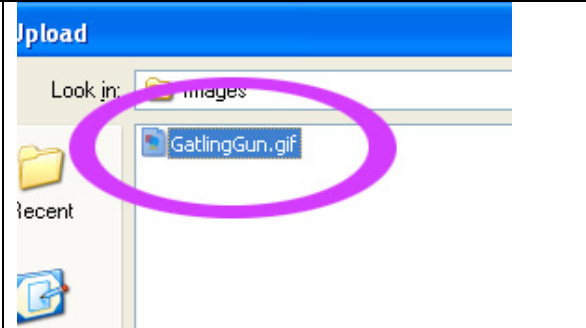
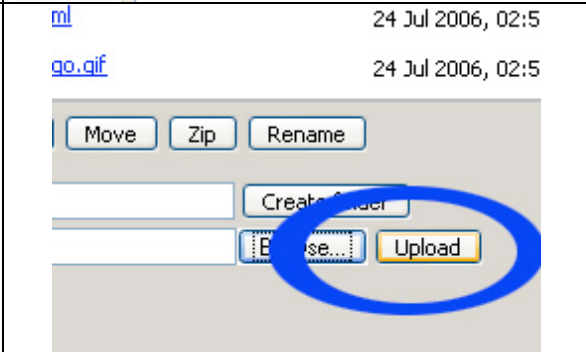

| <p>4</p> | <p>CLICK on the “Insert Image” icon (located on the toolbar, the 7th icon from the right in the bottom row).</p> |  |
| <p>5</p> | <p>CLICK “Browse...” (Located to the right of the bottom-most field).*</p> <p>* If you have used this image in Moodle before, or if you uploaded your image in advance, skip to step 8.</p> |  |
| <p>6</p> | <p>FIND the file on your computer or disk, and DOUBLE CLICK on it to select it.</p> |  |
| <p>7</p> | <p>CLICK “Upload” (located directly to the right of “Browse...”)</p> |  |

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| 8 | <p>DOUBLE CLICK on the name of the image in the “File Browser” window (located in the middle section of the window that pops up).</p> |  |
| 9 | <p>TYPE in a short description for your image in the field marked “Alternate text” (located directly under “Image URL” field).*</p> <p>*This text can be read by special screen-reading technology in order to make images accessible to visually impaired students.</p> |  |
| 10 | <p>CLICK “OK” (located directly to the right of the “Image URL” field).</p> |  |
